June has been a busy month for us and I can't believe it's going so fast! For most of us, June is when our gardens really begin to come in to full beauty and bloom. It is a great time to evaluate your perennial beds and see what you need to fill in.

One of my favorite native plants is coming in to bloom now, **Spigelia marilandica (Indian Pink)** and the butterflies and hummingbirds are just loving it! If you are not familiar with this lovely plant, log on to our website [www.nenativesandperennials.com](http://www.nenativesandperennials.com) and look in the photo gallery. It's the first picture there. It is very well behaved, about a foot high and the clump spreads to about 12". They prefer part shade. It is very underutilized and I would love to introduce it to you and your garden. It should be planted before July 15<sup>th</sup>, to get established before winter, so if you haven't already, hurry on over and pick up one or two for your garden. You will definitely be rewarded for the effort!
